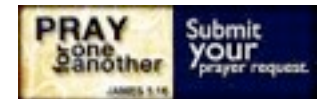

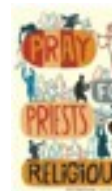

That the language of love and dialogue may always prevail over the language of conflict.

Liturgy of the Word
Daniel heard the word of the Lord describing an end time where those who sleep will either awake to life everlasting or to everlasting disgrace. In the second reading we hear that by Christ's one sacrifice, we are made perfect. In the Gospel, Jesus tells of the day that the Son of Man will come in glory to gather His elect.

The sacrifice of Jesus is perfect and complete, atoning for our sins, and He will one day come again to gather to His side all of us who have followed Him. In doing this, He will judge between the living-those who have remained faithful to His commandments-and the dead: those who lived lives not as disciples. Christ's judgement, then, simply reflects our status, it doesn't impose it. God has chosen us for His own we are the elect. Let us respond by choosing it for ourselves, as well.

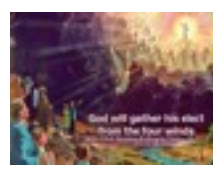

SSPP Parish Wide Advent Prayer and Fasting For Healing.
Advent season is supposed to be a time prayer, reflection, and preparation for the birth of our Lord at Christmas.
