

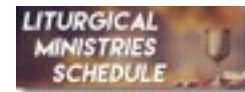

Gospel reading: John 20,1-9

Discovery	Commentary
1 On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. 2 So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him."	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> V.1 begins the story of the resurrection. The first character to appear is Mary of Magdala. She goes to the tomb before daybreak and sees the stone cover removed from the tomb. In v.2, right away she reports to Simon Peter and to John. She does not interpret well the removal of the stone. She believes the body of Jesus has been stolen overnight (or perhaps it was transferred without their permission), for she says, "we don't know where they put him."
