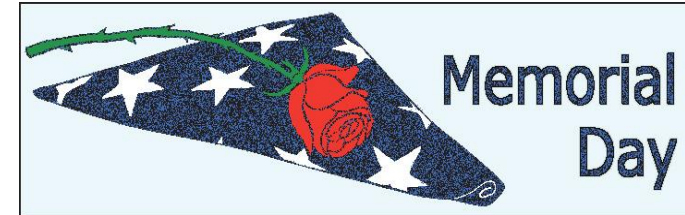
THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OUR FAITH
